Covid-19 in Indonesia

- Indonesia is late in responding Covid-19. The government tend to undermined the virus threat and was not transparent.
- At least, **44 health workers** die
- Marginalized community impacted the most, including LGBTIQ, children, and women
- Ministry of Women and Children Protection found that **30% of** laid off workers are women
- There is also indication **the escalation of domestic violence** experience by women and children

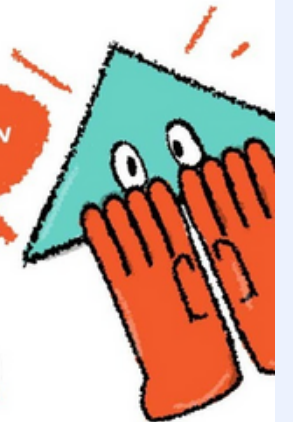

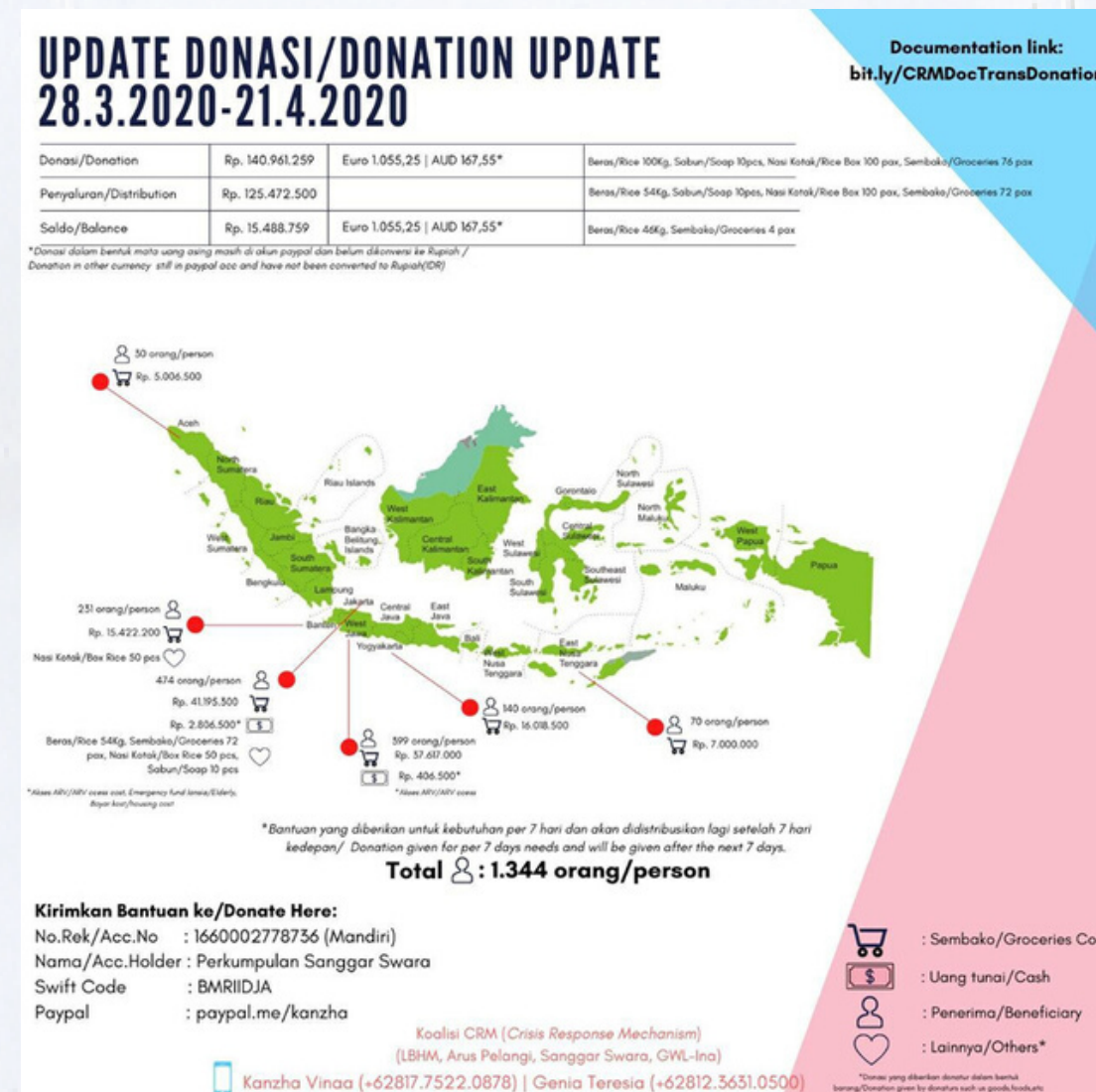

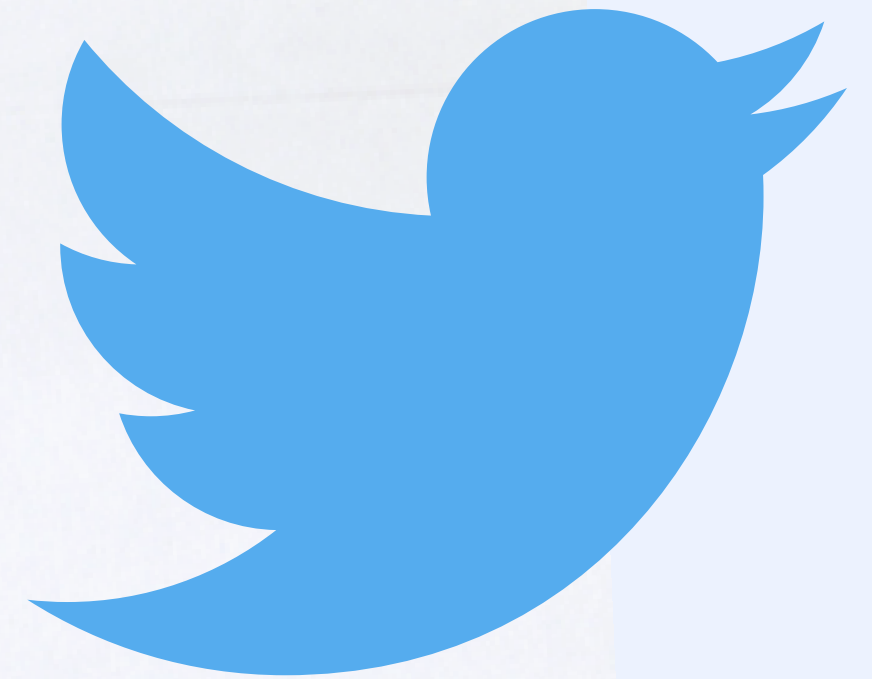

Obstacles

1. Bank Account Imposture

In terms of public donation, there are several cases where a person changes the destination bank account in the poster to his/her personal account. It is a crime that so far hasn't been responded well by Indonesia national police force. It also reduces the amount of help accumulated to assist the frontline medical workers, most impacted communities, etc.



Obstacles

2. Internet and Data Privacy

According to a report of Motherboard, Zoom send the user data to Facebook. The data was sell including **location and face of the user**. Electronic Frontier Foundation (EFF) found that Ring also sell our data to analytic companies.

Zoom and similar application are not supported with end to end encryption

In Indonesia, privacy is guaranteed through articles 28G in Indonesia's Constitution. But until now there is no specific law to regulate data privacy. Parliament and Government are still discussing about Draft of Data Privacy Protection Bill.



Obstacles

3. Online Gender Based Violence

300%

INCREASE IN 2019

According to **Amnesty International**, women activist are vulnerable to get threats of sexual harassment, intimidation, and murder.

Komnas Perempuan also found that cases of Online GBV increased to **300%** or 281 cases reported in 2019.



Obstacles

4. Criminalisation towards Expression

In Indonesian laws, freedom of expression is still hindered by several criminal articles on defamation, contempt, or blasphemy.

Police officer arrested Ali Bahransyah and three of his friend after criticizing Jokowi's measures in dealing with Covid-19.
